

### **BROCKTON-FOXVALE-TRI-CITY MIXED DOUBLES**

#### **TOURNAMENT RULES**

- 1. Must be currently USBC members of Foxvale, Tri-city, or Brockton USBC Bowling association prior to the closing date of the tournament.
- 2. ENTERING AVERAGE-(IN DESCENDING ORDER)
  - A. Highest USBC certified average of 21 games or more for the 2013-2014 season. Multiple memberships may bowl providing they have an established Tri-City, Foxvale or Brockton USBC Bowling Association average.
  - B. 2014-2015 winter League average as of January 1, 2015 with 21 games or more and verified by the league secretary. Verification must be presented to the tournament officials prior to bowling.
  - C. All others will bowl scratch.
  - D. USBC Youth Averages will not be accepted.
- 3. PARTICIPATION- Three(3) games bowled across 6 lanes.
- 4. Handicap is 90% of the difference between the entrant's average and 220
- 5. USBC RULES 319a2, 319d, 319c and 319e will not apply
- 6. Prize fund to be returned 100%-Handicap 70%, Scratch 30%. Prize fund will pay at least 1 in 10 entries.
- 7. Awards will be given to the 1st place Handicap and Scratch winners
- 8. In the case of a 1<sup>st</sup> place tie, a three game roll-off will decide the winner. Date and time to be determined by the Tournament Management. All other tied positions-monies will be combined and divided equally.
- Substitutes will be allowed if all eligibility requirements are met. If a substitution is made the substitute will bowl the entire series. NO PACERS OR ABSENTEE SCORES ALLOWED.
- 10. Tardy bowlers may start anytime, however a zero will be given for each frame missed.
- 11. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than the correct average, thereby resulting in a higher handicap. It is the responsibility of each bowler to verify the accuracy of their own average.
- 12. Check in time shall be 30 minutes prior to squad time. USBC cards MUST be presented at this time.
- 13. Lane assignments will be made in the order of receipt of entry.
  No reracks allowed without tournament official approval.

- 14. Multiple participation will be allowed, but must re-enter with a different partner. This must be done by entry close date.
- 15. All USBC rules will apply unless defined
- 16. Previous prize fund winnings need not be reported.
- 17. Bowlers placing in both catagories, (handicap and scratch) shall receive the prize of greater value.
- 18. The Mixed Doubles Tournament Director will settle all disputes and complaints. All protests must be submitted in writing to the Mixed Doubles Tournament director within 72 hours of the event. NO SMOKING OR DRINKING OF ALCOHOL during the tournament. NO HATS, HEADGEAR, IPODS OR CELL PHONES ALLOWED.
